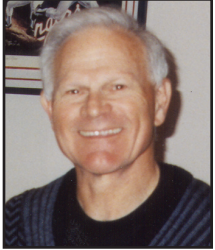




President's Corner

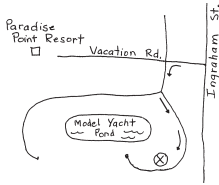
